Why we hold and process information?

This notice sets out how I hold and process information I hold about you. This includes:

- if you've attended an event, your details will be saved and you will be contacted about future events.
- if you've contacted me directly, I will save your contact details to inform you of classes and events.

How long we store your personal information for

I will not keep any personal data about you for any longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data is processed. I will not transfer or share your personal data.

Your rights

Under the GDPR, you have the following rights:

- Right to correction. You have the right to have inaccurate personal data about you rectified.
- The right to erasure. You have the right to request that I delete your personal data where: (a) the
 personal data are no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or
 processed; (b) you withdraw your consent to processing for which I previously obtained your consent;
 (c) you object to the processing and, as a result, I agree to cease that processing; (d) the personal
 data has been unlawfully processed; and (e) I am required to erase the personal data in order to
 comply with the law.
- **Right to object.** You have the right to raise an objection to any of our processing as outlined above. Please tell me if you object to any type of processing that I do, and I will work with you to address any concerns you may have.
- **Right to object to marketing**. If you do not want me to process your personal data for direct marking, please tell me and I will ensure that we no longer do this.
- **Right to complain to the ICO.** Whilst I would always prefer it if you approached me first about any complaints or queries you may have, you always have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office.
- **Right to request access**. You have the right to access a copy of personal data I hold about you. Please contact me on the details provided below.
